

Marina and RV Park Division Report January-February 2023

Marina Update:

As of January 1st, new Marina Lease Agreement and slip prices have been implemented. The City also made digital work order request forms available to all our moorage holders at the marina. In 2022, a vessel sunk in the marina. After a lengthy process, we have completed removal of the boat from the facility. Lastly, new security cameras have been installed at both the Marina and RV Park.



RV Park Updates:

The RV park just finished up winter long-term reservations. About half of the 14 sites available for long-term stays were booked for the entire winter. We did not fill all sites due to some electrical limitations. We are starting to see an increase of daily reservations being made for the spring, summer and fall. We decided to limit the dry storage area at the marina to boats and boat trailers only. Some of the RVs in dry storage were in poor repair and attracted unwanted activity. At the beginning of the year, RV owners were notified they had until March 31st to relocate their vehicles.

Boyd's Place Update:

Between January and February, Boyd's house has been reserved for 24 days to four different parties. Currently, we have reservations for March through September.

Marina an RV Park Future Updates:

There are a lot of projects and events to look forward to. Below are some of the highlights:

- The City of Umatilla will sponsor the Columbia River Walleye Tournament on March 25th & 26th at the Marina.
- We have planned our first ever seaworthy/safety vessel check with Senior Deputy Officer Hayes in April. This will give moorage holders and the public the opportunity to have their vessels inspected to Coast Guard and Oregon State Marine Board standards.
- We are looking forward to a busy season at the RV Park. We are already all booked up for the main holidays like Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day weekends.
