January and February Program Report:

Ice Rink

The Umatilla Ice Rink closed on February 20th. Due to the weather, the last day of the ice rink was actually not open to skaters. Participation at the ice rink dwindled at the end of the season. This may have been due to a variety of factors from school events to unexpected weather. Solely looking at transactions between 1/6 to 1/29 there were 122 transactions at the ice rink (includes admission and concession purchases) and 11 between 2/3 to 2/18.



Kids Bingo

The Recreation Division hosted monthly Kids Bingo Nights throughout the beginning of the year. Attendance has stayed steady averaging between 10-15 kids at each night. Parent's stay and participate with their children. The program has been popular.
